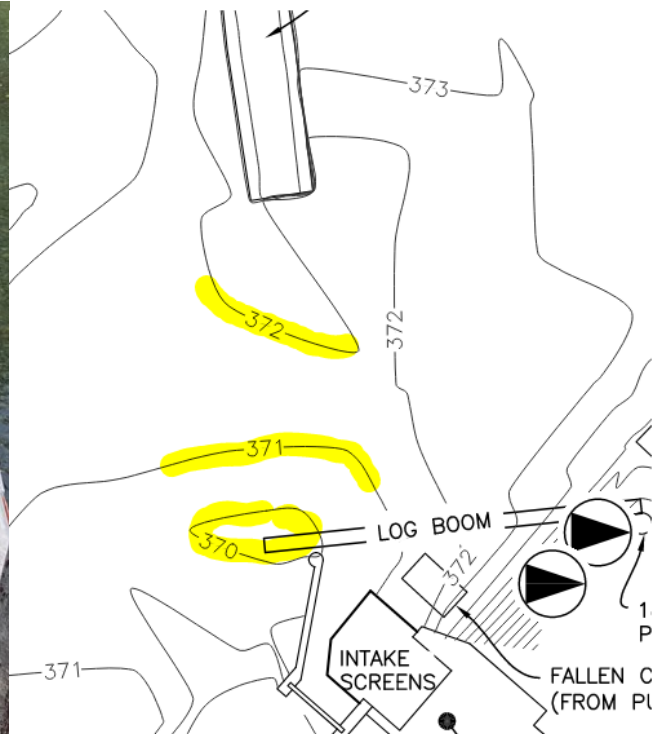


Project Summary: Weir Elevation & Flow Management at State Fish & Wildlife Fish Hatchery - 2023

This project is by the State Fish and Wildlife for a Fishery stream / weir. The US Fish and Wildlife did use the rock bags at the temporary weir. "They worked very well."

The rock bags are helping to fill in the elevation difference from the intake side of the Fish Hatchery to where the old weir block are located. You can see where the log boom is located is where we have the rock bags with two supersacks positioned on top of it followed by four more supersack immediately behind the ecology blocks.

Photo below of the weir was taken on 8/8/2023. The water level in the river is dropping as you can see, which is typical this time of year and that's why we have the weir in place to get the water to our hatchery intake.



The rockbags are covered under our HPA permit as well as our USACE Nationwide Permit, which allowed for the use of fill in our water system.

The Weir project was completed successfully and is a model being proposed for other Fisheries.

We plan on leaving them in there once we remove the supersacks and the ecology blocks mid-October 2023.
